*This article maps the evolution of forensic social work in the United States in light of its past history and future possibilities. It begins with English Poor Laws of 1601 and Colonial Era and the establishment of forensic policy in the North American colonies, then focuses on the late 19th and early 20th century creation and establishment of the social work profession and its forensic aspects, and finally to the contemporary expression of forensic social workers to carry out or change those policies.
